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

# Salisbury North Carolina


- Located in Rowan County

- Equal distance from three major metro areas, along Interstate 85






# Rowan Regional Crime Information Center (RRCIC)

- Developed and led by Salisbury (NC) Police Department, SMART Policing Initiative (SPI)
- It is the primary mission of the RRCIC to be a centralized location, wherein each Rowan County agency can be represented and contribute to the process of gathering and sharing information.
- The RRCIC will collect, evaluate, analyze, and disseminate information and intelligence regarding criminal activity in, and around, the Rowan County Area while following all applicable laws to ensure the rights and privacy of citizens.

  - Awareness of problem persons






# Our Future: Scaling the Success
